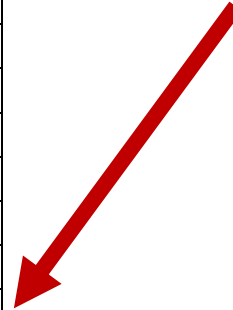


**Emergency Services District 2 Tax Levies (total taxes charged to property owners)
