CITY OF LINDALE - CHARTER ELECTION (Summaries of ballot language)

Prop 1: To make the City's annexation authority conform to recent changes in state law

Prop 2: Eliminates term limits for mayor and councilmembers

Prop 3: Requires 4 of 5 councilmembers rather than a simple majority (3 of 5) to override mayor's objection to an ordinance, resolution, or any official action passed by the city council

Prop 4: Establishes a 3-councilmember quorum for regular meetings and a 4-councilmember quorum for special meetings. Quorum is no longer defined to include the mayor, but councilmembers only.

Prop 5: Two instead of three council members may call a special meeting
