Election Integrity:
Adherence to the Texas Constitution and
Transparency in Unique & Sequential Ballot Numbering
for DRE Electronic Voting Systems

Dear General Paxton:

Thank you for prioritizing election integrity in the Texas Attorney General's Office. With recent news reports about voter fraud and multiple ongoing investigations by your office, it gets clearer every day how important honest elections are in Texas and how much work there is to do to secure ballot integrity.

Your commitment to Texans was made crystal clear when you stated in a recent Dallas press conference, "Nothing is more sacred to our democracy than the integrity of our voting process," and that your office would, "do everything within our resources and abilities to solidify trust in every election here and around the state." ***All of Texas is grateful for your dedication to honest elections.***

We therefore ask you to turn your attention to improving the security of computerized voting conducted with Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) voting systems in Texas. There are numerous legal requirements that must be met for state certification of such electronic voting equipment.

Your office has one of the most important roles in preserving election integrity – that of jointly certifying DRE equipment with the Texas Secretary of State's Office. We know you agree that we must ensure checks and balances are in place, and that all Texas Constitutional and Election Code provisions are strictly adhered to for computerized voting.

Since 1891, our Texas Constitution has mandated **unique, sequential, ballot numbering in Texas**. It has come to the attention of the Texas Conservative Grassroots Coalition that numbering of ballots as outlined in the Texas Constitution ([Article VI, Sec. 4](http://www.statutes.legis.state.tx.us/DocViewer.aspx?DocKey=CN%2fCN.6&Phrases=%22Numbering%22&HighlightType=1&ExactPhrase=True&QueryText=%22Numbering%22)¹) and the Texas Election Code ([52.062](http://www.statutes.legis.state.tx.us/DocViewer.aspx?DocKey=EL%2fEL.52&Phrases=52.062&HighlightType=1&ExactPhrase=False&QueryText=52.062)²) is not being enforced with regard to DRE voting systems in Texas. We are deeply concerned (and alarmed) that millions of tax dollars have been and will be spent on voting machines that are out of compliance with the law.

We ask for your **direct attention** to this serious election integrity issue and request that you address it **personally** by **September 15, 2017**.

We respectfully request you take the following actions:

- 1) Meet with a representative group of Texas Conservative Coalition election integrity leaders to discuss the importance of a transparent and sound process for ensuring the unique, sequential numbering of ballots for DRE voting systems;
- 2) Review the Texas Constitution ([Article VI, Sec. 4](#)³) and the Texas Election Code (TEC [52.062](#)⁴) for the mandatory requirement for ballot numbering and ensure paper ballots and DRE electronic ballots equally meet all Texas suffrage and election laws;
- 3) Review Texas Supreme Court and Appeals Court [case law](#)⁵ related to mandatory requirements for ballot numbering for paper systems and DRE voting systems that employ paper ballot and ballot images ([TEC 213.106](#)⁶) for recounts;
- 4) Review the Texas Election Code ([122.001\(a\)3](#)⁷) that requires voting systems in Texas to meet the Federal Election Assistance Commission standards;
- 5) Review the [2015 Federal Election Assistance Commission](#)⁸ national standards for DREs, which specify DRE electronic ballots are to be uniquely numbered as defined by [2.4.4.2\(e\)iii](#)⁹ – “...produce a report of ballot images...For each voted ballot...providing a **unique identifier** for the ballot...:”),
- 6) Review the following evidence related to uniquely numbering DRE ballots:
 - a) DRE vendor certification evidence provided to your office,
 - b) vendor communications ([Hart](#)¹⁰ and [ES&S](#)¹¹) to the Secretary of State, and
 - c) affidavits from [Jacklyn King](#)¹² and [Dottie Barnes](#)¹³ of Navarro County
- 7) Develop corrective action plans to ensure DRE ballots are uniquely and sequentially numbered according to the Texas Constitution, Election Code, and federal standards, and the plans are transparent to voters.

General Paxton, as you well know, election integrity and ballot security have strong bi-partisan support. A government by and for the People can only exist when we have confidence that the results of each election are a **verifiable** reflection of the collective intent of eligible voters in each

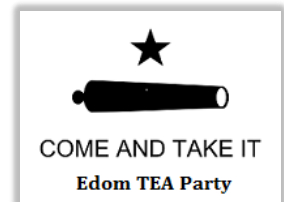

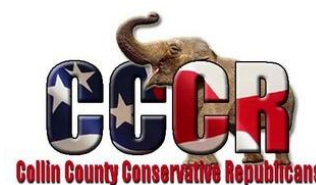
