WHEREAS, the security of the electric grid is a matter of grave importance to the citizens of
WHEREAS, the Electric Reliability Council of Texas has forecasted an increased likelihood of power outages during the Winter of 2023-2024, caused by decreased dispatchable generation and increased demand on the system; and
WHEREAS, physical and cyber attacks on electric grid infrastructure across the natior are increasing; and
WHEREAS, naturally occurring solar flares and the detonation of a low-level nuclear device emitting an electromagnetic pulse could result in catastrophic outages across the state;
WHEREAS, electricity is a lifesaving, essential resource, and imperative for local and national security; therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That hereby adopt this resolution in support of measures such as state legislation to secure the Texas electric grid from naturally occurring threats, as well as taking all reasonable actions to safeguard the Texas electric grid from malicious man-made attacks, including opposing all efforts to connect to the national grid, instead allowing Texas to strengthen and improve existing energy infrastructure through state-led initiatives.
